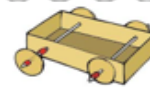

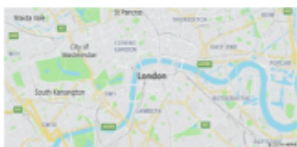
In Geography we will be asking...

What you can do to help:
